Currently included in HB4 for Division of Criminal Investigations:

All remaining fiscal year 2021 federal budget amendment authority for the cooperative disability investigations unit is authorized to continue into federal fiscal year 2023.

All remaining fiscal year 2021 federal budget amendment authority for the anti-methamphetamine program is authorized to continue into state fiscal year 2023.

Page D-19 includes:

Fund 03051 Homeland Security- This is a Department of Military Affairs grant that is received for the *MATIC (Montana Analysis and Technical Information Center)*. This grant provides the continued customer support through the sharing of information to prevent, protect, respond and recover from acts of terrorism and other criminal acts, ensure the protection of civil rights and liberties, develop innovative ways to improve the information sharing environment utilizing improved technology, act as the central repository for critical infrastructure and criminal intelligence information, and enhance customers ability to protect critical infrastructure.

Fund 03187 Board of Crime Control Grants- These are subgrants the Division received for:

- Southwest Drug Taskforce Overtime
- Eastern Montana Drug Task Force Overtime
- Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act Grant funding (assist Montana in moving forward toward more substantial implementation of SORNA, the Compliance Area of Immediate Transfer of Information, and the Compliance Area of Required Registration Information, capture of offenders' palm prints.)
- Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (which is used to manage the grant personnel and associated operating expenses, equipment, travel, etc., contract with a community advocate and contract, through a procurement process, the testing of sexual assault evidence kits.)
- Victims of Crime Act funding and Ombudsman (specialized services tailored to the distinct needs of victims of crime)

Fund 03542 DCI Overtime Agreements- DEA, ATF Taskforce overtime agreements.

Fund 03800 Medicaid Fraud- This an award to support the Medicaid Fraud unit within Division of Criminal Investigation with US Health and Human Services to investigate and prosecute Medicaid fraud and patient abuse and neglect in healthcare facilities.

Fund 03811 NCHIP- This award allows DOJ to increase staff and equipment to improve dispositions on file, provide onsite training regarding arrest fingerprint submissions and disposition reporting, and manage aspects of the project, develop on-line training curriculum, and deploy electronic fingerprint capture devices countries in MT currently without them.

Fund 03476 DCI ICAC Grants- This federal award by the National Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force Program, consisting of State and Local law enforcement task forces dedicated to developing effective responses to enticement of children by sexual predators, child exploitation, and child obscenity and pornography cases.

Fund 03454- DCI Federal Grants- Establish new agreement with Social Security Administration related to operation of Cooperative Disability Investigations Unit.
