




### Video Gambling Tax Collections

Video Gambling Machine (VGM) tax collections for the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012 (April, May, and June) were approximately \$14.3 million. That was very close to the same as the previous quarter, but \$1.5 million (12%) more than the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2011. Overall, FY12 tax collections were 8.7% more than FY11. All VGM tax collections are deposited into the State General Fund.



### Liquor and Gambling Licenses


In the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012, the Division received 80 gambling, liquor, and combined liquor gambling applications (including amended applications). This is 15 less than the 95 applications received during the fourth quarter of last fiscal year.



## Video Gambling Machine Permits

An individual video gambling machine permit fee is \$220 for the full fiscal year and is reduced by a prorated amount each subsequent quarter of the fiscal year. A portion of the fee (45%) goes to the local government where the machine is located and the balance goes to the Gambling Special Revenue Fund.

During the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012, 907 video gambling machines were issued permits, almost 200 more than fourth quarter of fiscal year 2011.



## Card Games and Bingo

- By the end of fourth quarter, the number of card tables licensed during fiscal year 2012 was 295. This is down 37 tables from the same time last year.
- The number of card dealers licensed at the end of fourth quarter 2012 was 516, down 33 from the same time last year.
- The total number of bingo and keno licenses issued in FY12 remained at 74 in the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012, a decrease of 12 from the fourth quarter of fiscal year 2012.
