A motor vehicle that is brought, driven, or coming into this state is exempt from the registration fees imposed in MCA 15-24-301 if the motor vehicle is registered in another state or country by a nonresident person who is a licensed health care professional, as provided in MCA Title 37, chapter 3, 8, 11, 14, 20, 25, 28, or 34, and who is employed in Montana by a health care facility as defined in MCA 50-4-504 that is located in an area that has been: 1) designated by the Secretary of the federal Department of Health and Human Services as a health professional shortage area, as provided in 42 USC 254(e); or 2) determined to have a critical shortage of nurses, as provided in 42 USC 297n(a)(3).

This form and the \$2.00 fee for each decal must be turned into the County Treasurer of the county in which the health care facility is located. The county will issue the decal. Money collected from this fee must be deposited in the county general fund.

Current window decal must be displayed on the lower right-hand corner of the windshield. Decal can either be affixed to outside of windshield or taped to the inside of the lower right-hand corner of windshield.

Decal will expire each year on December 31 of the year in which issued, and application for re-registration must be filed with the County Treasurer no later than February 15 of each year.
