Interstate Excepted: Operates in interstate commerce but engages exclusively in transportation or operation excepted under 49 CFR 390.3(f), 391.2, 391.68, or 398.3*.

Compliant with Montana law, you operate in **excepted interstate commerce** when you drive a commercial motor vehicle (CMV) in interstate commerce **only** for the following excepted activities (**check all that apply**):

- As federal, state or local government employees
- To transport human corpses or sick or injured persons
- Fire truck or rescue vehicle drivers during emergencies and other related activities
- Primarily in the transportation of propane winter heating fuel when responding to an emergency condition requiring immediate response, such as damage to a propane gas system after a storm or flooding
- In response to a pipeline emergency condition requiring immediate response, such as a pipeline leak or rupture
- In custom harvesting on a farm or to transport farm machinery and supplies used in the custom harvesting operation to and from a farm, or to transport custom harvested crops to storage or market
- Beekeeper in the seasonal transportation of bees
- As a private motor carrier of passengers for non-business purposes
- To transport migrant workers

If you checked one or more of the above activities as the **only** operation in which you drive, you operate in an **excepted interstate commerce status** and do not need a federal Medical Examiner's Certificate (MEC).

If you did not check any of the above activities, you operate in a **non-excepted interstate commerce status** and are required to carry and provide a copy of a current MEC (49 CFR 391.45), commonly referred to as a medical certificate or DOT card, to the MT Motor Vehicle Division. **Most CDL holders who drive CMVs in interstate commerce are non-excepted interstate commerce drivers.**

If you operate in both excepted interstate commerce and non-excepted interstate commerce, you cannot use this form and must be in a non-excepted interstate commerce to be qualified to operate in both types of interstate commerce.
