



We were made aware of a data breach through our previous 3rd party application site, Empty Rentals, and have reported it to the Bozeman police, the FBI, and the Montana Office of Consumer Protection. Social Security numbers were a part of the breach. We have shut down everything on our end. Do not reply to any fishing emails or open any links.

The police detective did let us know that this is common and they get multiple calls everyday regarding businesses being hacked. They are doing all that they can to get this under control asap.

If you are worried about your credit they suggested either putting a credit freeze on your account through all three of the credit bureaus (I believe you can do it online) or check your own credit score periodically to see if any accounts have been opened and then file an identity theft report.
