The Montana Attorney General's Office is proud to offer up to ten grants of up to \$2,000 each to Montana pharmacies that would like to establish a Safe Medication Disposal Program in their pharmacy. The funds can be used for the purchase and/or installation of a permanent collection box, signage, destruction of the collected materials, advertising for the program or any other related expense. Grant awardees will be required to document and submit data about their individual programs to the grant administrator on a quarterly basis. Examples of requested data include staff hours spent attending to the program, amount of materials collected by weight, community response to the program, etc.

On a separate page, please detail:

1. Why a permanent take-back program will benefit your community and where the secured and locked disposal box will be located.
2. How your pharmacy would spend the funds if awarded (detail a specific budget for the \$2,000) AND how you will continue to fund the Safe Medication Disposal program once you have spent the grant money.
3. How the collected materials will be destroyed.
4. Any oversight methods that will be employed and how they will ensure compliance with DEA regulations.
