Seller's Checklist

- You must be the owner listed on the title. Every owner listed on the title has to sign over the title to the buyer.
- If the title is lost or damaged, apply for a replacement.
- Resolve any security interests/liens (money owed anyone) listed on the title. Once the loan is paid off, apply for a new title with no liens listed, or give the buyer a completed form MV37A Release of Security Interest or Lien.
- Keep a written record of the sale; include the buyer's contact information and vehicle information.
- Remove the license plates before giving the vehicle to buyer.

Note to Seller: Keep this receipt as record of sale and delivery of the vehicle to the buyer. (For a more formal record, use form MV24 Bill of Sale.)
